

I. Personal Property

Crossroads Leadership College, Crossroads Church, its officers, directors, employees, and any and all representatives are not responsible or obligated to repair or compensate any damages to or theft of your personal belongings and vehicles. Participants are responsible to provide security and protection for all personal belongings brought to and purchased during their time at CLC.

The student is responsible for personal toiletries, sheets, towels, clothes, medicines, etc., as mentioned in the list of *Items to Bring*. Please bring only what is needed due to limited storage space.

II. Conduct

Crossroads Leadership College, Crossroads Church, its officers, directors, employees, and any and all representatives are not responsible for participant's misconduct while enrolled. Crossroads Leadership College is designed for those at the legal age of 18 and above. Any participants under 18 years of age will be in an adult environment and expected to carry out the same responsibilities as others.

III. Housing/Property

Crossroads Leadership College will provide housing for all students. No one may move into CLC housing until the specified date communicated upon acceptance. If you arrive early, it is your full responsibility to secure housing until the specified date given. Crossroads Leadership College will provide a microwave, stove, oven, fridge, & furniture for common area seating for each apartment. Many apartments also have been equipped with dishes, pots, pans, and basic cleaning supplies however they vary from each apartment.

Any damage to housing or property of Crossroads Leadership College/Crossroads Church will be the responsibility of the student to replace or fix.

IV. Medical

We request that all students be **fully covered by health insurance**. All CLC participants are considered full-time students and therefore should fall under parental health insurance policies.

You are responsible, whether you have medical insurance or not, for all medical bills. Including those caused by injuries that occur during Crossroads Leadership College. Crossroads Leadership College is not responsible to pay for any hospitalizations, medical bills, prescriptions, or appointments.

V. Vehicle

It is the full responsibility of each participant to acquire and keep **current** auto insurance and cover vehicle maintenance costs. Crossroads Leadership College is not responsible to repair any student's vehicles.

If, while attending Crossroads Leadership College you use someone's vehicle and have an accident, receive a citation, and/or misbehave in any way, you are fully responsible to cover all expenses and damages while you were in possession of the borrowed vehicle.

Students will receive a fuel card as reimbursement for mileage used for ministry purposes. It is each student's responsibility to keep a mileage log and turn it in.

VI. Terms of Dismissal

Crossroads Leadership College, its officers, directors, employees, and any and all representatives reserve the right to dismiss a student at any time. There will be immediate dismissal for any of the following: immoral behavior, tobacco, alcohol, drug use, theft, violence, lack of payment, and/or failure to adapt to the program standards.
